


IAAF/ Cardiff University World Half Marathon Championships - 26th March 2016



Role Description: Volunteer Photographer

You will be undertaking a key role in capturing the atmosphere of race day from one of the key locations around the course such as the start, finish or a water station. The atmosphere will be electric as 25,000 runners from across the world take on the iconic 13.1 course, with the world watching.

Some of the tasks involved in your role are;

- Take pictures of the runners, the volunteers and the public, trying to reflect the atmosphere of the day.
- Focus on volunteers interacting with the runners
- Try and capture the action as well behind the scenes, we want to know what goes on!
- Ensure the photos are appropriate for further use, such as volunteer recruitment campaigns
- Make sure you keep a safe distance from the course and do not impede the runners when taking photos

You must have a camera that you are happy to use on race day but everything else you need will be waiting for you, you just need to turn up with lots of energy and enthusiasm!

There will be a face to face briefing to go through everything you need to know for race day (date tbc) as well as a run through on the morning by the role supervisor.

As a thank you, you will receive a;

- Adidas volunteer uniform (Jacket and bag) to be worn on race day but yours to keep!
- Volunteer Lanyard with key information
- Food and drinks
- Training and support

By volunteering you are joining a large community of volunteers called the 'Extra Milers' who are 'Making the Diff'ERENCE' to ensure runners and spectators alike have the best experience possible!
