Role Description: Race Guru

You will play a key role in supporting runners and spectators around the different aspects of the event. You will be the go to volunteers, providing information about the race, where to drop their bags, answer any questions and help solve problems. There will be food, drink, entertainment, the atmosphere here will be electric!

This role is very fluid on the day and we will need to move you between different tasks around the start and finish areas as and when required.

Some of the tasks involved in your role are;

- Act as a point of contact for runners and spectators on the day
- Look after runners and spectators, directing them to where they want to go.
- Meet and greet runners and spectators as they arrive in the city
- Help to maintain the event experience
- Support the operation of the entertainment areas in the city centre
- Be positioned on umpire chairs directing people around the start/finish
- Help runners get to where they need to go after they cross the line

You will be very busy on the day but everything you need to undertake your role will be waiting for you, you just need to turn up with lots of energy and enthusiasm!

As a thank you, you will get;

- Adidas volunteer uniform (Jacket and bag) to be worn on race day but yours to keep!
- Volunteer Lanyard with key information
- Food and drinks
- Training and support

By volunteering you are joining a large community of volunteers called the 'Extra Milers' who are 'Making the Difference' to ensure runners and spectators alike have the best experience possible on race day!
